Mode of admissions

- Direct admission on the basis of 12th percentile - 25% seats
- Eligibility - Pass 10+2 Examination (minimum of 5 subjects) with Physics and Maths being compulsory.
- Admission through SAJEE (St. Andrews Joint Entrance Examination) - 25% seats
- JEE counseling - 50% seats

6 simple steps

1 Course selection

2 Mode of admission

The student can apply for direct admission to any undergraduate program bases on there 12th % or if any students require scholarship to support there studies they can apply in the SAJEE examination on www.sajee.in and take the test in different test centers all across India.

3 SAJEE or selection on the basis of 12th percentage

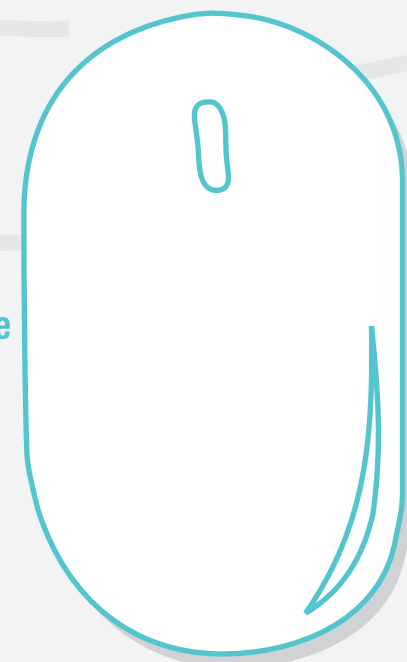

5 Fee deposition

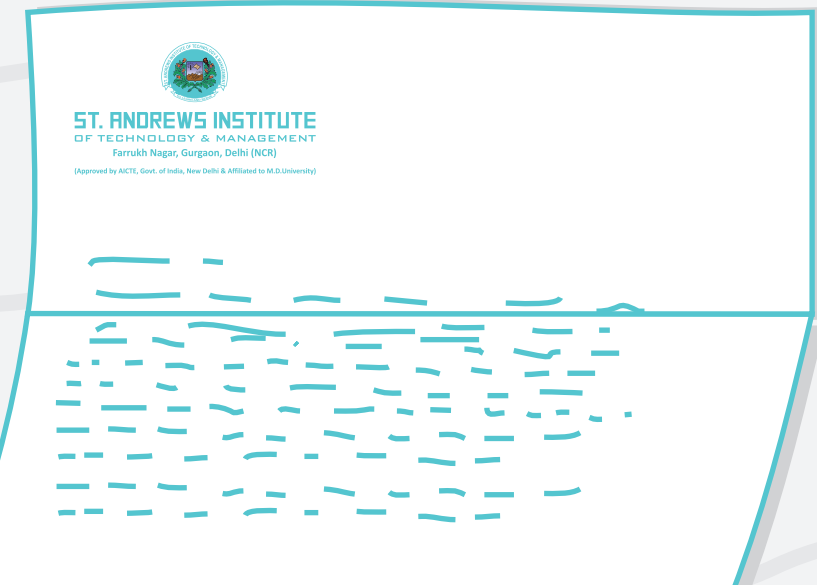
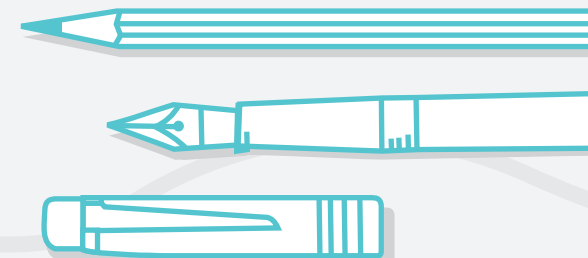
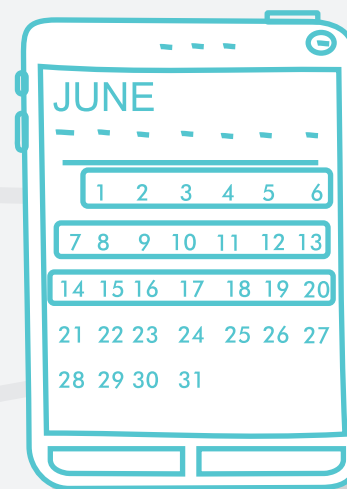
- Once you will have proof of Admission i.e. Admission letter, you can deposit the first installment of fees by the following methods: -
